

Randolph County Commissioners

February 14, 2014

The Randolph County Commissioners met a special meeting at 9:00AM in the Commissioners and Council Room in the Courthouse with the following members present: Board President Michael Wickersham, William Terrell and Gary Girton. Also present was Randolph County Auditor Mary Ann Lenkendorf and County Attorney Meeks Cockerill.

Michael Wickersham, President presided over the meeting.

Appointment of Building Commissioner-

Wickersham asked if any of the Commissioners had a recommendation for building commissioner. William Terrell stated he would recommend Randy Bertram. Wickersham stated he thought that Terrell had considered Daniel Rismiller. Terrell stated that he had called on a reference for him and it was very good but it was Terrell's understanding that Rismiller couldn't start until the middle of March or April. Michael Wickersham stated that there were two jobs that Rismiller needed to finish and there would need to be someone else to inspect. I'm sure we could hire Bill Pearson to finish those two inspections. William Terrell stated he would then nominate Daniel Rismiller. Gary Girton seconded the motion. All aye votes cast. Motion carried. Michael Wickersham stated he had talked with Daniel Rismiller prior to the meeting and told him that he would be nominating him for the job if no one else did. Wickersham also told Rismiller that if he was successful in the nomination would he accept the job position. Rismiller indicated he would accept. Meeks Cockerill stated that Wickersham should tell him it is a conditional offer of employment. Michael Wickersham telephoned Rismiller in the meeting.

Meeks Cockerill stated that Commissioners should vote to include the ADA coordinator position and inspector for the new nuisance ordinance into the Building commissioner job description since that was the indication of what Commissioners wanted. William Terrell made a motion to include the ADA coordinator to the building commissioner position and remove that job from the assistant highway superintendent. Also add inspector for the nuisance ordinance effective immediately to the Building Commissioner job description. Gary Girton seconded the motion. All aye votes cast. Motion carried.


